

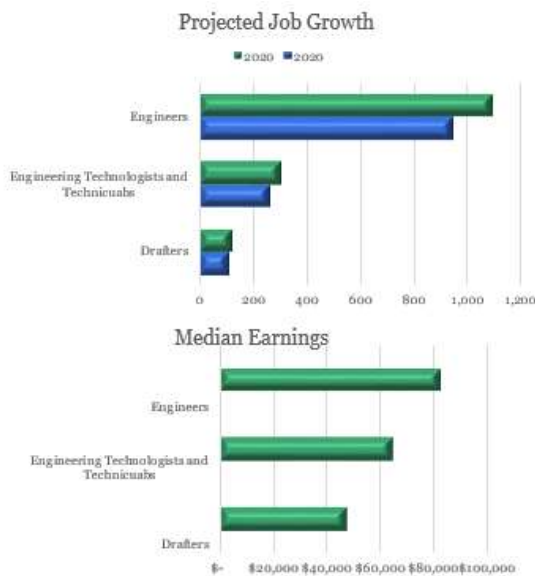


Engineering



If you are good at math and figuring out how things work, you can find high-paying job opportunities in engineering, technician, drafting, and surveying.

More than 320 people were hired for engineering-related jobs in 2019. Engineering jobs are vital to the success of many operations, and demand is expected to continue to grow at a high rate in the next 10 years. Engineering technicians and drafters, who assist engineers, also are in high demand. Overall, growth in this field is projected to grow 16 percent between now and 2028.

Schweitzer Engineering Laboratories is the region's largest employer of engineering and engineering technicians, who help design and make devices to manage electrical power grids. It employs more than 2,500 people in Pullman, 600 in Lewiston, and plans to open a plant in Moscow in a few years.
